



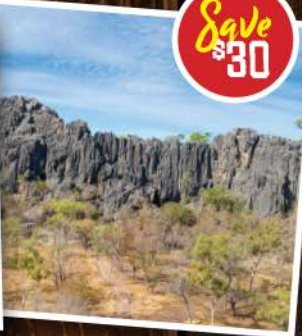

MORNING TEA AT SKYBURY CAFE

The heart of one of Australia's most diverse and richest food bowls Skybury Tropical Plantation has grown the country's best coffee and tropical fruit for the past 30 years.

HISTORIC PETFORD RAILWAY STATION

Named after John Joseph Petford, an official of Queensland Railways Department, this classic Outback Railway Station is preserved in time providing many photo opportunities.

**4**

PRIVATE RANGER GUIDED CAVE TOUR

Follow your guide through the fossilized remains of the ancient coral reefs over 400 million years old. Once an inland sea, these limestone labyrinths are spectacular.

**5**

CHILLAGOE SMELTER RUINS

At times, the mines, railway and smelter provided employment for up to 1,000 workers. Operating in the early 1900's, the abandoned ruins of a once bustling copper smelter and chimneys dominate the landscape.

LUNCH AT 100 YEAR OLD AUSSIE PUB

Burgers, Fish & Chips and Vegetarian meals are available and refreshments at own cost. Mingle with the locals and leave a hand written message on the wall of this classic Aussie Pub.

7 BALANCING ROCK

A circuit walk taking you uphill to a series of rock formations passing a few small caves along the way. You can walk up to a vantage point near Balancing Rock to view the entire Chillagoe Region.



8 ABORIGINAL ROCK ART

Appearing on a large face of the caves, view the ancient Aboriginal rock art by one of the oldest cultures in the world. These inscriptions are an important part of the Aboriginal Culture.



9 TROPICAL FRUIT TASTING

Indulge in a feast of exotic tropical fruits bursting with unique flavours such as Black Sapote, Soursop, Wattle Seed, Jackfruit, and Coconut.



10 GRANITE GORGE

A privately owned nature park near Mareeba with stunning scenery as you walk along the short circuit navigating massive boulders. Striking scenery and rich wildlife have been luring tourists since 1977.



11 HAND FEED THE WALLABIES

The big drawcard at Granite Gorge is the rock wallabies. This particular colony is an endangered species that is unique to the Mareeba area.
