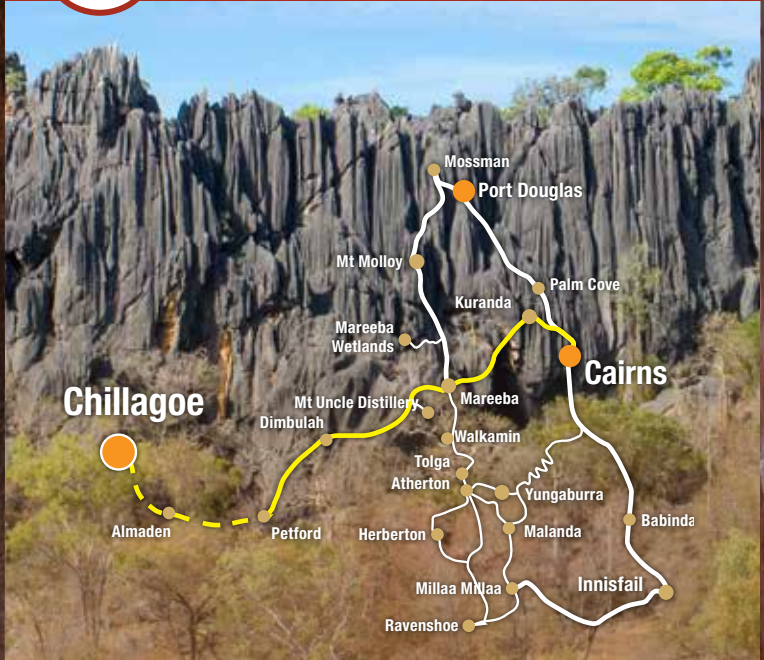

Appearing on a large face of the caves, view the ancient Aboriginal rock art by one of the oldest cultures in the world. These inscriptions are an important part of the Aboriginal Culture.

TROPICAL FRUIT TASTING

Indulge in a feast of exotic tropical fruits bursting with unique flavours such as Black Sapote, Soursop, Wattle Seed, Jackfruit, Pineapple and Coconut.

GRANITE GORGE

A privately owned nature park near Mareeba with stunning scenery as you walk along the short circuit navigating massive boulders. Striking scenery and wildlife galore.
