Enjoy a delicious lunch with your fellow travellers in the Daintree Rainforest. We cater for special dietaries.



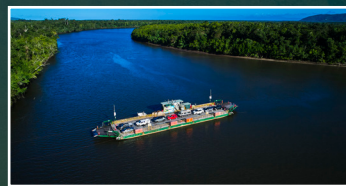
TROPICAL FRUIT ICE-CREAM
